

4. The *Licensee* agrees to offer a notice in the written description of the video (if there is one)—as posted on Vimeo, YouTube or any public video site—that the song is from the musical “Letters to Daddy” and provide a reference and/or link to the Licensor’s music website: <https://store.4eproductions.com>.

5. The *Licensee* agrees to reference that the song “Together We Can Change the World” is available via Amazon, iTunes, CD Baby and other online distributors.

6. The *Licensee* agrees to take all reasonable efforts to ensure the *Music* is not presented within or associated with content that the *Licensor* considers inappropriate. If, in the reasonable judgment of the *Licensor*, it objects to the content associated with the *Music*, it must notify the *Licensee* of its objections and give the *Licensee* 5 days to make adjustments necessary to satisfy the *Licensor*. If the objections are not satisfied within the sole judgment of the *Licensor*, the *Licensor* has the right to terminate the agreement.

7. *Licensor* hereby represents and warrants that: (i) the *Music* is original and *Licensor* owns all rights related thereto; (ii) *Licensor* has the right to enter into and perform this Agreement (without the consent of any other party); (iii) the terms of this Agreement will not contravene any other agreement to which *Licensor* may be a party; and (iv) *Licensor* is a member of ASCAP.

8. This agreement serves as a legal execution to obtain a limited license for the *Music*.

9. This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States of America and the State of Connecticut, applicable to agreements made and to be performed entirely within such State.

10. This agreement may not be amended or modified, except in writing signed by both parties hereto.
